

SIERRA MADRE POLICE BLOTTER

June 11 – June 17, 2006

During the week of Sunday, June 11th, to Saturday June 17th, the Sierra Madre Police Department responded to approximately 192 calls for service. The following is a brief summary of a few of these calls, which the department handled during this period.

Sunday, June 11th:

10:10 PM – Disturbance, 100 block West Sierra Madre Blvd. A resident called to report a man yelling at patrons of a local restaurant. Upon arrival officer found a man matching the description. Officers determined the man to be intoxicated and arrested him. The man was transported to the Pasadena Jail for booking.

Monday, June 12th:

2:22 AM – Traffic stop, Highland Ave and Auburn Ave. Officers stopped a vehicle for a minor traffic violation. While conducting the investigation officer found a small amount of a substance believed to be methamphetamine. The driver was arrested for a narcotics violation.

Tuesday, June 13th:

12:35 AM – Traffic stop, 600 block East Sierra Madre Blvd. While on patrol, 600 block of east Sierra Madre Blvd. An officer saw a car driving at a high rate of speed. A records check revealed a prior narcotics conviction. The officer found drug paraphernalia and hashish oil. Both the driver and the passenger were arrested for possession of hashish and transported to the police station for booking.

Wednesday, June 14th:

9:20 AM – Traffic stop, 300 block West Sierra Madre Blvd. Officers conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle registration violation. While conducting the investigation, the driver was believed to be under the influence of alcohol. The driver failed a field sobriety test. The driver was arrested and transported to the Pasadena Jail for booking.

Thursday, June 15th:

7:30 AM – Officers from the Sierra Madre Police Department and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department served a search warrant, culminating a lengthy investigation. One resident was arrested and booked at Los Angeles County Jail for receiving stolen property, identity theft and forgery.

Friday, June 16th:

11:27 PM – Suspicious person, Memorial Park. Officers were dispatched to the park regarding an intoxicated person. On arrival officers found the man. He was arrested for public intoxication and transported to the Pasadena Jail and booked.

Saturday, June 17th:

9:44 PM – Disturbance, Alverno High School. Officers were dispatched to the school regarding a disturbance at a wedding reception. The disc jockey was intoxicated and harassing the security officer. Officers conducted an investigation and the arrested one man for drunk in public. He was transported to the Pasadena Jail for booking.
