

SIERRA MADRE POLICE BLOTTER

Week of Sunday, September 10 to Saturday, September 16, 2006

During the week of Sunday, September 10th, to Saturday September 16th, the Sierra Madre Police Department responded to approximately 158 calls for service.

Sunday, September 10th:

6:55 PM – Vandalism, 186 West Highland Ave. A resident who was jogging in the area reported a possible vandalism at the vacant Youth Activity Center. Officer found a broken window, but otherwise the building was secure.

Monday, September 11th:

6:15 AM – Arrest, Fane Street. A resident called the station to report a person breaking into parked cars. Officers found a man matching the description. During a pat down search, Off. Ginter found burglary tools in the man's pocket. The man was arrested for possession of burglary tools and a \$295,000 Pasadena burglary warrant. The suspect was also on probation for burglary. Tuesday, September 12th:
